Environmental education is a process that allows individuals to explore environmental issues, engage in problem-solving, and take action to improve the environment. As a result, individuals develop a deeper understanding of environmental issues and have the skills to make informed and responsible decisions.

With the support of NORAD (Norwegian embassy, India) we had organized 1440 workshop for environmental education in 6 district (Solan, Sirmour, Shimla, Hamirpur, Mandi and Bilaspur) in year 1993-to 1998. The main theme was the Recycling of Solid waste it may be office paper waste or household waste. The total 43,200 students and teachers were trained and aware of the current concern of the environmental.

The impact, Government of Himachal Pradesh had started a solid waste management program in all districts. Amongst 12 districts the responsibility of Solan District, We had taken. After 12-year successfully management of the plant with the suggestion of NORAD, we have handover this plant to Solan Municipal council. In the Solan district, 20 ton of wastes every day are being treated.
